# THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

## PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens :

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

## FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES (CHAPTER IV A)

### ARTICLE 51A

It shall be the duty of every citizen of India —

- (a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and to adjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.
- (k) Who is a parent or guardian to provide opportunities for education to his child or, as the case may be, ward between the age of six and fourteen years.

Provision for the teaching of a subject would be made in the Vidyalaya provided at least ten students opt that subject.

# **ADMISSION RULES IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS (2019-20)**

Admission to Class I are made in February-March as per KVS guidelines. Admission to Class II and above are made in April, subject to the availability of seats and as per KVS rules. Admission on transfer from other Kendriya Vidyalayas can be done at any time during the academic year subject to certain stipulations/norms.

## **ELIGIBLE AGE FOR ADMISSION**

A child must be at least 5 years old as on 31st March of the academic year in which admission is sought for Class-I. For subsequent classes the eligible age would be reckoned again with reference to the 31st March with a proportionate increase over five years. Maximum age limit for admission is fixed as the minimum age limit plus two years. The maximum age would be further relaxed by two years to handicapped children only by the Principal.

## **PRIORITIES IN ADMISSION**

The following priorities shall be followed in granting admissions:-

1. Children of transferable and non-transferable central government employees including ex-servicemen. This will also include children of foreign national officials who come on deputation or transfer to India on invitation of Govt. of India.
2. Children of transferable and non-transferable employees of Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/Institute of Higher Learning of Government of India.
3. Children of transferable and non-transferable state government employees.
4. Children of transferable and non-transferable employees of Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/Institute of Higher Learning of the State Governments.
5. Children from any other category other than the above said including the Children of foreign nationals who are located in India due to their work or for any personal reasons. They would be considered only in case there are no Indian nationals wait listed for admission.



## METHOD OF ADMISSION IN CLASS I

Out of the available seats of fresh admission 15% will be reserved for SC and 7.5% will be reserved for ST. The short fall in the number of seats reserved for SC and ST, will be worked out after considering number of SC/ST children admitted under RTE quota.

1. In first phase, 10 seats (out of 40 seats) in Class I per section are to be filled as per RTE Provision (25% of seats) and these 10 seats will be filled by draw of lots from all applications of SC/ST/EWS/BPL/ OBC (Non Creamy Layer) residents of Neighbourhood/Differently abled taken together.
2. In second phase, remaining seats are to be filled as per existing Priority category system. The short fall in the seats reserved for SC/ST, if any shall be made good by admitting SC/ST applicants.

For example : In a single Section School 6 seats are reserved for SC and 3 Seats for ST (15% for SC and 7.5% for ST). Assuming that, 2 SC candidates, 1 ST candidate and 1 Differently Abled candidate are admitted under RTE in the lottery system in first phase, then available SC seats will be considered as  $6-2 = 4$  and ST seats will be  $3-1=2$ . The left out registered candidates from SC and ST category will be considered as per order of Priority categories for admission. In this case the remaining 24 seats will be available for admission under order of Priority of Category.

## METHOD OF ADMISSION IN CLASS XI

**KV Students** Admission in different streams viz Science, Commerce, Humanities of Class XI in KVS for KV students will be based on aggregate marks scored in class X exams as under:

1. **Science Stream** : A minimum of 60% Marks in aggregate of all subjects.
2. **Commerce Stream** : A minimum of 55% Marks in aggregate of all subjects.
3. **Humanities Stream** : All students of KV if declared successful in class X exam.

**Note** : If seats remain vacant in class XI even after admitting the children of KV/neighbouring KVs then the admissions to non-KV children may be granted on the same criteria, in the sequence of categories of priority.

**Note 1. (i) Fee will be charged quarterly in advance through U.B.I.**

**(ii) The fee is to be paid on or before the 5th of the first month of the quarter. Thereafter a late fine/higher contribution of Rs.5/- per day will be charged till the last day of the month. In case tuition fee and VVN are deposited late, the late fee fine/higher contribution will be Rs. 10/- per day.**

**(iii) The name of a student is to be struck off the rolls if the fee is not paid till the last working day of the month. Such a student can be re-admitted only on payment of a re-admission fee of Rs. 100/- together with up-to-date dues including the fine/higher contribution.**

**2. The children of the parents who are living below poverty line will be allowed exemption from Tuition fee & VVN up to two children. The Parents coming under this category will have to apply to Principal along with certificate of below poverty line (BPL Ration Card) issued by competent authority for exemption.**

**LEAVE** A child may be allowed to leave the school in very special cases with the permission of Principal. The leave application should be sent to school the same day or latest by the next day, duly signed by the father or mother of the child. **During tests and Examination no leave will be granted except on medical ground and a medical certificate from authorised Medical Officer has to be attached with leave application.**

Long leave on any other ground shall not be allowed, except under very special circumstances and at the risk of the parents.

**ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL** No child is expected to be absent from the school without a valid reason and a leave application from the parents is to be produced on the next day he/she comes to school. If a child continues to be absent for 10 working days without valid leave application, his/her name shall be struck off the school roll for continuous absence and he/she may not be re-admitted to the school.

**WITHDRAWAL** At least 3 days notice in writing on a prescribed form duly signed by the guardian, is to be given, before withdrawing a student from the school.

**MEDICAL FACILITIES** Efforts shall be made for medical check-up of the students once/twice in a year and it is recorded in the progress report of the pupil.

## **EDUCATION CODE-ARTICLE 60. [FOR STUDENTS]**

- a) The following acts and conduct on the part of the students will amount to misconduct:
- i. Misbehaviour towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
  - ii. Intentional disturbance of classes.
  - iii. Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher/Vice-Principal/Principal.
  - iv. Bullying / intimidation of others.
  - v. Eve-teasing/ misbehaviour towards girl-students.
  - vi. Damaging/ disfiguring school property.
  - vii. Propagating a strike/ disruption of classes.
  - viii. Association with banned organizations.
  - ix. Propagating communal / caste feelings amongst the students.
  - x. Indulging in physical violence of any manner.
  - xi. Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher / Vice-Principal / Principal.
  - xii. Bringing unauthorized people / articles inside the school.
  - xiii. Theft / pilferage of school / students' property.
  - xiv. Any behaviour unbecoming of a student.
  - xv. Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
- b) In above acts of misconduct, Principal shall take suitable action as per observation of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include.
- i. Oral / written warnings to the student and parents.
  - ii. Suspension from attending classes / school for a specified period.
  - iii. Recovery of loss to school property.
  - iv. Issue of transfer certificate.
  - v. Expulsion/ rustication from school.
